

Sixth Form

We provide financial help for eligible students to support their education in two ways:

16-19 Discretionary Bursary Fund

Students eligible for free school meals are entitled to claim from their bursary amount for items such as:

- travel,
- instrument tuition,
- educational trips,
- university interview travel costs,
- books and equipment.

Bursary amounts vary from year to year, but are normally in the region of £750.

Students who are not currently eligible to claim for free school meals, but have been eligible at any point in the last six years, are able to claim up to £200 per year for specific educational purposes as above.

Defined Vulnerable Groups Bursary

Eligible students receive a total of £1,200 per year, paid termly directly to the student.

Eligible students are:

- Young people who are looked after (in care), including unaccompanied asylum-seeking children,
- Young people in receipt of income support (or universal credit) in their own name,
- Young people in receipt of both Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance in their own name.
