Please note that places are limited to 40 and we must have an initial deposit of £150 per paying passenger be received by Friday 20th October 2017. (As we expect demand to be high we may have to allocate places on a first out of the hat basis.) The second deposit of £100 must also be paid by 8th December 2017. The outstanding balance will need to be paid by 16th February 2018. Please note that these deposits are non-refundable in the event that your daughter withdraws from the trip.
