Dear Parents

A-level Trip to Lyon, France April 2019

We are delighted to be able to offer our Year 12 and 13 students of A-level French the chance to take part in a residential trip to Lyon, France, **Thursday 25th April – Monday 29th April 2019**. This visit will give the students the opportunity to experience French culture first hand and to practise their French in an authentic environment and will support their A-level studies.

The cost of the trip, including all activities, return travel, outings, entrance fees, meals and insurance will be approximately **£698.70**, payable in three instalments which are non-refundable if your daughter withdraws from the trip at a later date. Payments are required as follows:

- a deposit of £350 on or before Friday 28th September 2018.
- a second payment of £200 on or before Friday 30th November 2018
- the balance on or before Friday 25th January 2019

The price includes:

- Return flights
- 1 Item of checked in luggage per person
- 4 Nights' accommodation on a Bed and Breakfast basis
- 4 evening meals at local restaurants
- 3 hour language lesson at Lyon Bleu
- Musée des Confluences
- 1 hour river cruise
- Institut Lumière
- Museum of the Resistance
- Chocolate tasting

If your daughter is in receipt of the 16-19 bursary, and would like to use this to fund this trip, please ask her to see our Finance Officer, Mrs Kennedy, by Friday 28th September to complete the necessary form.

The overall cost of the trip has been calculated using current prices and in good faith to cover the anticipated costs. In the event of a surplus after all costs have been met, any negligible amount will generally be transferred into School Fund to benefit the girls' learning. In the event of a significant surplus (in excess of £10 per pupil) this will be refunded to parents.

There will be an information evening about the trip (date to be confirmed) and further information will be sent home via pupils.
