On the day, the coach will leave from school at 7.45 am prompt and return to school at approximately 5pm. There is an hour lunch break where students are unsupervised and able to buy lunch from the local area

Visits are dependent on the generosity of parents making a contribution towards the cost, which in this case is **£34**. Payment and consent should be made via ParentPay. If you are unable to use ParentPay please contact Mrs Kennedy, our finance officer.

If your daughter is in receipt of the 16-19 bursary, and would like to use this to fund this trip, please contact Mrs Kennedy.

All school trips are subject to the school's Code of Conduct, which please bring to your daughter's attention. A copy of the school's Code of Conduct can be found on the school's website, Parents and Students tab, select Trips and Visits.

The deadline for payment and consent is Friday 19th October at the latest as we need to secure tickets and therefore your co-operation would be appreciated.

The overall cost of the trip has been calculated using current prices and in good faith to cover the anticipated costs. In the event of a surplus after all costs have been met, the amount will generally be transferred into School Fund to benefit the girls' learning.

It is also essential that the school has the most up to date medical information about your daughter and that she carries with her any medication she may require during the day. School staff are not allowed to administer medication.
