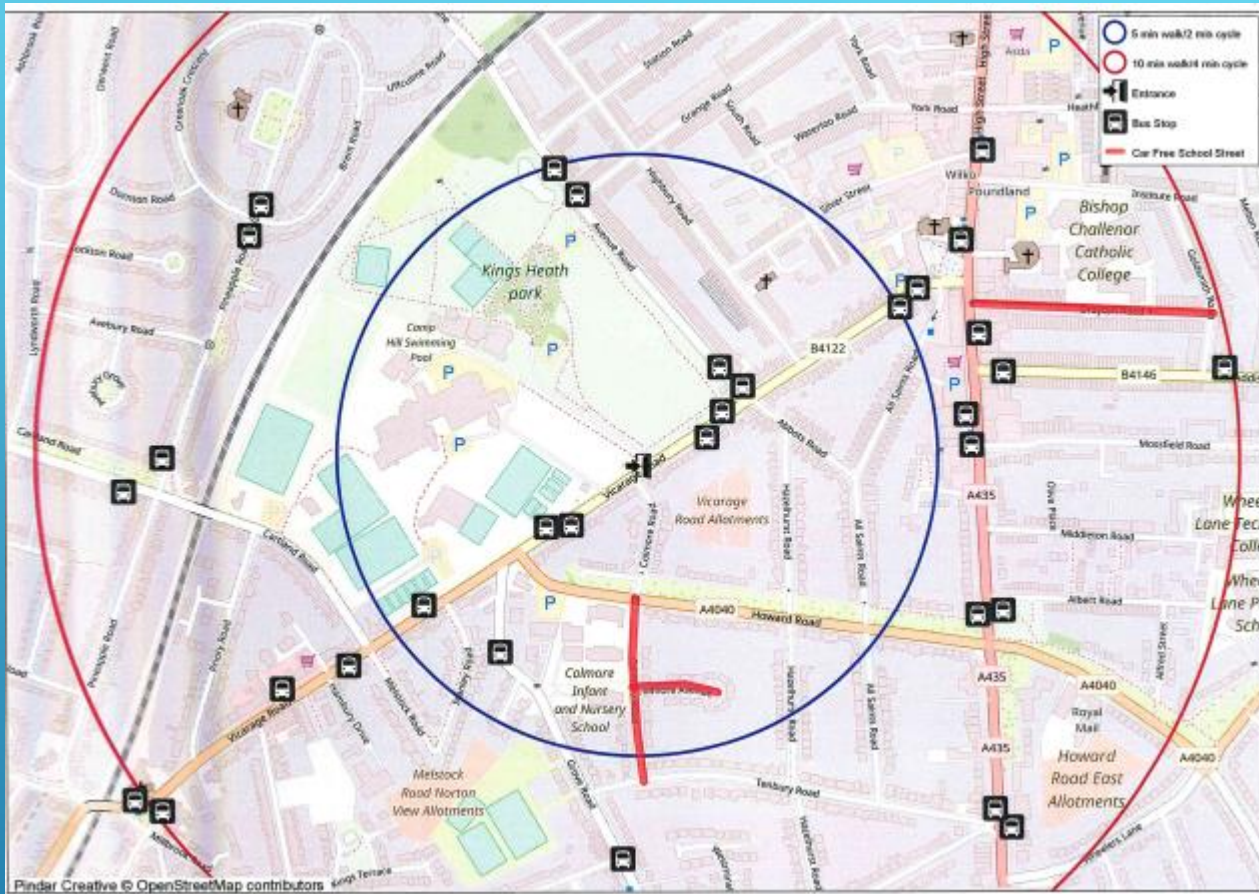

# KECHG SUMMER SCHOOL: 14TH-16TH AUGUST 2024


- ▶ Arrive each day for **8.45am**. No cars on-site.

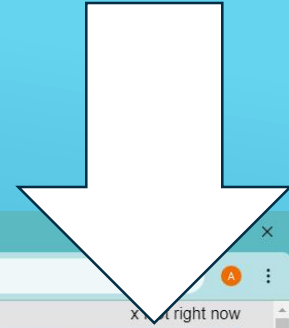

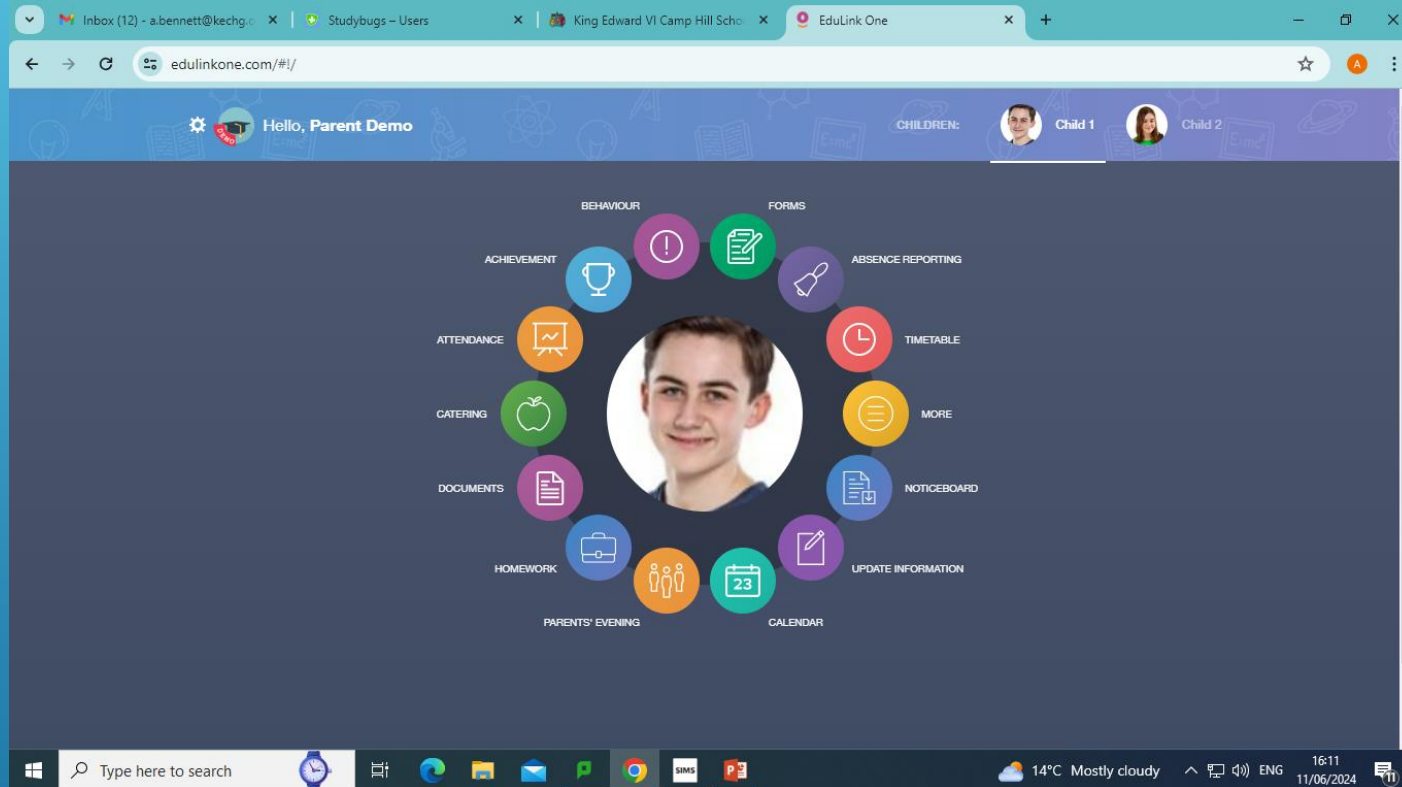

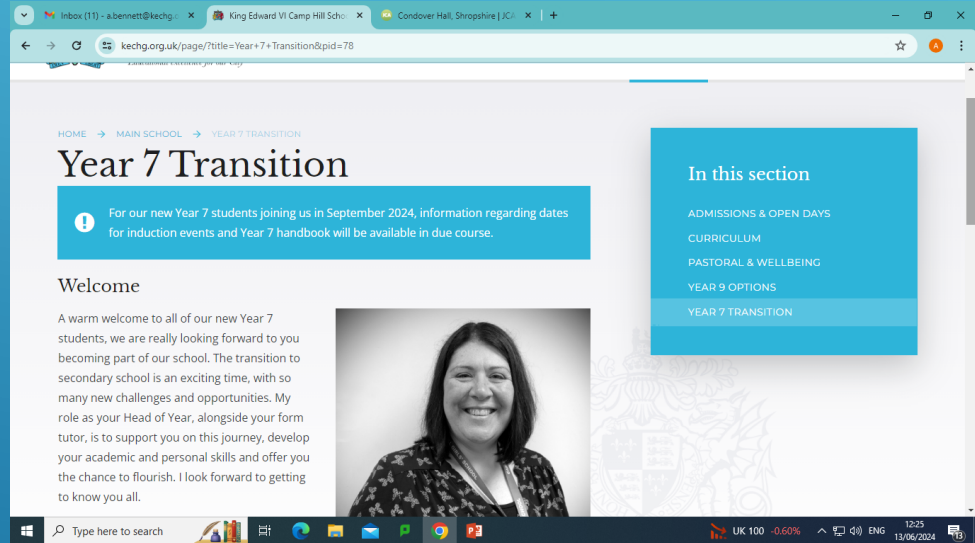
