## Introduction

This policy (together with the documents referred to in it) tells you the terms of use (“Terms”) on which you may make use of our website, <http://www.kechg.org.uk>, (the “website”), whether as a guest or a registered user.

### 1. Information about us

- 1.1 The website is operated by King Edward VI Camp Hill School for Girls (“we”, “us”, “our” or “The School” as the context permits).
- 1.2 We are a charitable company limited by guarantee, registered in England and Wales, company number 10654935, registered office Edgbaston Park Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham B15 2UD.

### 2. Information about you and visits to our website

All personal data will be processed in accordance with our Privacy Policy. By using our website you consent to such processing and you confirm that all data provided by you is accurate.
